GENERAL ENTRY RULES (GER) AUDI FIS SKI WORLD CUP BAD KLEINHEIM

- 1) The boundary of the event site and spectators' area will be determined by a by-law issued by the Kurgemeinde Bad Kleinkirchheim.
- 2) Entry to the event site only with a valid entry permit (entry tickets, accreditation). The entry ticket will lose its validity on leaving the event site. By purchasing an entry ticket or obtaining an accreditation, the visitor accepts the terms of these entry rules.
- 3) The officers of the supervisory and security services are authorised to search people wishing to gain admission to the event, and the containers they carry, for dangerous items. These also include pyrotechnical items. The officers of the security service are authorised to deny admission to the event to people who refuse to be searched or who wish to take dangerous items onto the event site. Admission will also be denied to people who are obviously under the influence of alcohol.
- 4) It is not permitted to bring food or drink of any kind, especially alcoholic drinks, to the event! The officers of the supervisory and security services are authorised to check containers for compliance with this regulation!
- 5) The unauthorised placement of advertising materials of any kind (e.g. transparencies, brochures, newspapers and magazines, etc.) is strictly prohibited.
- 6) Radio, film and TV recordings may only be made by people specially authorised for this. Photography only for personal use.
- 7) All dirt and damage within the event area and the facilities must be prevented. The following are particularly prohibited within the event area: Tearing down and cutting off tree limbs or branches, damaging, dirtying or moving any items, emptying out water and other liquids, lighting fires and fireworks. Paper, food remnants, polystyrene and similar, and other waste of any kind must be deposited in the waste bins provided.
- 8) It is imperative to follow the instructions of the supervisory and security officers for maintaining order and safety. Action will be taken if the entry rules are disregarded or entry permits are misused and the result will be expulsion from the event site.
- 9) The person concerned must provide evidence of his/her identity if these entry rules are violated.
- 10) Changes to the programme are possible and are subject to the decisions of the jury, the event organiser or the event organising body.
- 11) Please note - Alpine terrain! Spectators must adapt their conduct and equipment to the special conditions of a natural winter landscape. The main spectators' area is located close to the finishing line. The racing section itself is located in the steep wintry natural landscape and is not accessible or is subject to restricted access on foot or on skis; any appropriate instructions and barriers must be observed. It is recommended that you equip yourself suitably for the alpine terrain in the event area.
- 12) The event organiser accepts no liability for any losses which the purchaser or owner of this entry ticket suffers before, during or after the event or in direct or indirect connection with the event, apart from that for which compensation cannot be excluded.

GENERAL TICKET SALE CONDITIONS (GTSC) AUDI FIS SKI WORLD CUP BAD KLEINKIRCHHEIM

- § 1 – **Validity:** These GTSC are valid for both individual persons and legal entities (companies). All contracts will be executed solely on the basis of these GTSC. Any deviation from these GTSC will only be valid in the written form.
- § 2 – **Entry to the Event Site:** The event organiser's General Entry Rules (GER) and the relevant suspension regulations of the Kurgemeinde Bad Kleinkirchheim are valid with regard to entry to the event site.
- § 3 – **Effectiveness:** The ticket sale will become effective on payment of the ticket price. By paying for the ticket, the ticket customer agrees to the GTSC and the GER.
- § 4 – **VIP Ticket Dispatch:** VIP tickets will be credited to the event organiser's account after receipt of payment and sent to the customer's address by recorded delivery by 23 November 2007; if ordered later, VIP tickets must be collected in person at the OK office, Kirchheimer Weg 1, 9546 Bad Kleinkirchheim. (Weekdays from 9:00 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 17:00)
- § 5 – **Event Risk:** The tickets are valid for a specific date but are not tied to a specific racing event (discipline). The racing events in question are open-air events; thus the risk of programme changes, postponements and cancellations is deemed to be a typical risk.
- § 6 – **Cancellation:** Tickets may be returned by the ticket customer, stating the customer's address and bank details (IBAN + BIC), up to 10 days prior to the first racing event of the relevant racing weekend (ticket cancellation). The corresponding ticket value will be reimbursed within 28 days from the date of return minus a 10% processing fee. The date the tickets are received at the event organiser's premises is deemed to be the date of return. Later cancellation of the tickets is excluded.
- § 7 – **Race Cancellation in Good Time:** The ticket organiser will reimburse the ticket value if the entire racing event (all scheduled races on one racing weekend) or parts thereof are cancelled up to 10 days prior to the first scheduled racing event of the relevant racing weekend. In this case, the tickets concerned must be sent by recorded delivery to OK AUDI FIS SKI WORLD CUP ALPINE, Kirchheimer Weg 1, 9546 Bad Kleinkirchheim within 28 days of the cancellation date stating the customer's address and bank details (IBAN + BIC). Reimbursement will be made within 28 days of the event organiser receiving the tickets minus a 10% processing fee.
- § 8 – **Race Cancellation** There will be no reimbursement of the purchase price on cancellation, total or partial non-performance of a racing event, for whatever reason (weather, force majeure, national mourning, etc.) and by whatever official authority (competition jury, public authority, etc.), at any time from 9 days prior to the first racing event of a relevant racing weekend.
- § 9 – **Race Postponement:** In the event of a postponement of the race (grand slalom or slalom) to another day, the validity of the relevant ticket will be shifted simultaneously to the replacement date for the race originally scheduled.
- § 10 – **Compensation:** The event organiser will not be liable for the costs which may be incurred by the customer (compensation such as travel costs, board and lodging, etc.) due to a possible race cancellation or race postponement.
- § 11 – **Data Protection:** The event organiser will store the data taken from the customer, which is necessary for execution of the contract, in electronic form. This data is subject to data protection and will only be used by the event organiser for his own purposes and will not be passed on to third parties.
- § 12 – **Miscellaneous:** The place of fulfilment is Spittal an der Drau. Any invalidity of one or more provisions of these GTSC will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. In all cases of invalidity of these GTSC, an invalid provision must always be replaced by another which comes closest in commercial meaning to that which is invalid but is itself valid.
